5-MILE RUN

Beginning at the Wharf Street Parking Garage, runners will follow Clay Street to the end, turn right onto the paved Caperton Rail Trail and head north past Hazel Ruby McQuain Riverfront Park (HRMRP) to the WVU Core Arboretum (WVU AC). Upon entering the WVU AC, runners will encounter a single-track dirt trail until the mid-point of the loop back onto the rail trail. Runners will complete the final two miles on the rail trail to the finish line near HRMRP – just before the Decker's Creek Bridge. Except for a slight uphill approach to the WVU AC, the course is primarily flat or downhill.

2-MILE WALK for Individuals or Families

Beginning at the Wharf Street Parking Garage, walkers will follow Clay Street to the end, turn left onto the Caperton Rail Trail, go south to a turnaround point past the Morgantown Lock and Dam and return to the finish line behind Oliverio's Ristorante.
