


## Micah Wilson Memorial Scholarship

## **ABOUT THE FUND**

The Micah Wilson Memorial Scholarship is established in remembrance of Micah Wilson, a 2011 University High School graduate. This scholarship provides funding to students who plan to enroll in an eligible public or private higher education institution.

## **ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES**

To be eligible to apply for funding, students must have completed their junior year in high school, achieved a 2.5 GPA (if planning to attend a technical or trade school) or a 3.0 GPA (if planning to attend a college or university). Applicants are required to submit a recommendation from a teacher or counselor addressing whether the student has performed up to his or her potential. Students who do not meet the GPA requirements may still be considered if recommended by a teacher or counselor for special consideration.



Additionally, applicants must demonstrate intent to enroll as a full-time student in an eligible public or private higher education institution by submitting verification of enrollment from a college, university, technical or trade school upon selection for the award. This is a non-renewable scholarship; you must reapply during the next scholarship cycle if you wish to be considered for funding again.
