ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

The recipient must be a resident of Harrison County, West Virginia pursuing post-secondary education at a trade or vocational school, or a two-year or traditional four-year college or university. The recipient must be in good academic standing as well as demonstrate financial need. Scholarship recipients are eligible to apply for renewal for a period of four (4) years if the recipient continues to meet the eligibility requirements and is in good standing at the educational institution the student is attending.

HOW CAN I DONATE?
