He graduated from University High School in 1989 and attended Johnson and Wales University in Providence, R.I., where he graduated Magna Cum Laude in 1992 with an associate degree in Culinary Arts and a bachelor's degree in Hospitality.



He went on to work in the restaurant industry for several years before beginning his career as a small business owner. This scholarship will honor his memory and serve to enable a student with similar ambition to succeed. He is greatly missed by his family, friends and colleagues.

ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

This scholarship is for graduating seniors of University High School who are enrolled full-time, pursuing post-secondary education at an accredited trade, vocational, two-year or traditional four-year college or university. Priority will be given to those applicants with financial need. This is a non-renewable scholarship.
