## **About the Fund**

The Morgantown Art Association Endowment Fund was established in 2015 to support the activities and projects of the Morgantown Art Association (MAA) and its artists.

For more than half a century, the non-profit MAA has given creative individuals a place to share their love of art as well as their artwork, and with the support and participation of its members, it will continue to thrive for years to come.

Its stated mission is "to bring together all those individuals interested in the creative arts."

The MAA began as an outgrowth of art classes for senior citizens in Monongalia County. In 1958, enthusiastic students organized into the MAA and began to display their art work in local businesses and churches.

The Association was housed for 10 years in the Garlow Building on High Street before moving to a house on Kirk Street and later into the newly established Morgantown Art Center at the former Morgantown Post Office. In 2004, the association was able to open its own gallery in the Mountaineer Mall where members could display their work and hold classes and meetings.

The MAA has continually held a membership of 75 to 125 members. It annually presents an Outstanding High School Art Student Award in three county high schools and offers workshops by outstanding out-of-state artists for the enrichment and growth of anyone interested in art instruction.

The Art Association has a continual and ever-changing display of artwork available for viewing by the public on the walls its gallery, open Tuesday to Friday from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.
