



James A. Womeldorff Vocational Development Scholarship

ABOUT THE FUND

Job Squad, Inc. has established an endowed scholarship for individuals with disabilities in honor of their former CEO, James A. Womeldorff.

This scholarship provides funding to a West Virginia resident with a documented disability who displays financial need and is seeking post-secondary education at a trade, vocational, two-year or traditional four-year college or university.



ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

To be eligible, applicants must (a) be a resident of West Virginia, (b) have documentation of a disability, (c) be pursuing post-secondary education full-time at a trade, vocational, two-year or traditional four-year college or university, (d) display financial need and (e) be in good academic standing.

Scholarship recipients are eligible to apply for renewal for a period of two to four years if the recipient continues to meet the eligibility requirements and is in good standing at the educational institution the student is attending. This scholarship does not automatically renew; you must reapply during the next scholarship cycle if you wish to be considered for funding again.
