ABOUT THE FUND

The Woodrow W. Woods Scholarship provides renewable scholarship funds to selected Harrison County residents attending a college, university, technical or trade school in West Virginia. This award is available for undergraduate and graduate students who study full-time and are in good academic standing.

ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

To be eligible for this award, students must (a) be a resident of Harrison County, West Virginia, (b) be unmarried, (c) attend a college, university, technical or trade school in West Virginia and (d) be an undergraduate or graduate student enrolled full-time with a good academic standing. Priority in awarding is given to those with limited financial resources.

This scholarship renews annually for up to four years, toward the completion of one degree program, provided the student continues to meet the requirements.
