ABOUT THE FUND

Established as the Class Gift of the West Virginia University College of Law Class of 2026, the Jennifer Powell Book Fund provides lasting, need-based support for future law students. Through annual book scholarships, the fund helps ensure that the cost of textbooks and other learning materials does not prevent students from succeeding.



The fund honors Jennifer Powell, Assistant Dean for Student Services and Engagement, in recognition of her decades of service to WVU College of Law students. It reflects the values she has championed throughout her career, including public service, access to justice, and student well-being.



Each year, distributions from the fund will be made through the WVU Foundation to support full-time WVU College of Law students with financial need. Beneficiaries will be selected by the Dean of Student Services, and funds may be used to purchase books and other required learning materials.

HOW CAN I DONATE?

The fund is managed by Your Community Foundation of North Central West Virginia, Inc. (YCF). YCF is a qualified 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization eligible to receive donations.

Any individual, organization, or business can make a tax-deductible contribution to the fund. Donations are accepted in the form of checks, credit cards, stocks and through bequests.
